Tepa Gold Project

Sefwa Gold Belt, Ghana

- Located within an established multimillion-ounce district, 40km south-east of Ahafo Gold Mine (750Koz annual production, 8Moz to date[^]);
- Along strike from the Bibiani (2.5Moz) and Chirano (2.1Moz) gold deposits[^].

Lennon's Find Project

Pilbara (VMS), Western Australia

- Granted Mining Licence.
- Five deposits identified along a pronounced 4.5km mineralised trend.
- Inferred Mineral Resource 1.55Mt @ 5.9% Zn, 0.2% Cu, 1.6% Pb, 0.28 g/t Au and 84 g/t Ag*.



Lennon's Find is highlighted by a pronounced 4.5km mineralised VMS corridor.

- Project covered by a Mining Licence.
- The mineralised corridor hosts the project's 1.55Mt Inferred Resource across five known deposits Grey Nurse, Tiger, Hammerhead, Mako and Bronze Whaler.
- A 2024 Induced Polarisation Survey, which extended earlier work, confirmed a deeper chargeability anomaly at Hammerhead and shallow chargeable responses at Tiger.
- The base metal mineralisation is predominantly zinc – lead – copper – silver – gold.



Rock chip locations along the 4.5km mineralised trend identified at the Lennon's Find Project.




A 650m diamond hole tested Hammerhead's copper-gold IP anomaly in December 2025.

- Assay results expected later in February with electromagnetic downhole testing to follow.
- The anomaly is interpreted to represent the feeder zone to the known zinc-lead-silver mineralisation.
- The program is supported by a \$110,930 grant from the WA Government's Exploration Incentive Scheme (EIS).

Orange can earn 51% of the Lennon's Find Project (M45/368) by spending \$500,000 by 31 March 2026. Orange may earn up to 75% of the Lennon's Find Project by spending an additional \$500,000 (\$1 million in total) by 31 March 2028.




Lennon's Find Project conceptual VHMS model.



The IP anomaly is coincidental with a magnetic linear trend and an overlying fault, thus increasing its prospectivity.

- Exceptional rock samples have been collected by Orange Minerals where the zone thins or has been displaced by NE-SW faults.
- The highest assay results from the sampling were gold (5.50 ppm), silver (2948 ppm), copper (5.29%), lead (22.40%) and zinc (5.70%).

The Tepa Gold Project lies 40km east of Newmont's Ahafo Gold Mine - 8Moz Au produced since 2006.

- Tepa covers 166km² across three exploration licences.
- Tepa is hosted within the mafic volcanic unit along strike from the gold-bearing shear/fault structures that host Asante Gold's Chirano (2.1Moz) and Bibiani (2.5Moz) gold mines.




Previous exploration at Tapa has identified anomalous gold values which have not been systematically followed up with modern exploration techniques.

- Further on-ground activities are required, initially in the form of soil sampling, to delineate gold anomalies to further progress exploration through targeted RC drilling.

Orange is in the final stages of completing the in-country legal, technical and regulatory processes required to complete the acquisition of the Tapa Project. During this period, the company has been completing preliminary exploration plans and will immediately commence field activities upon completion of the transfers.




